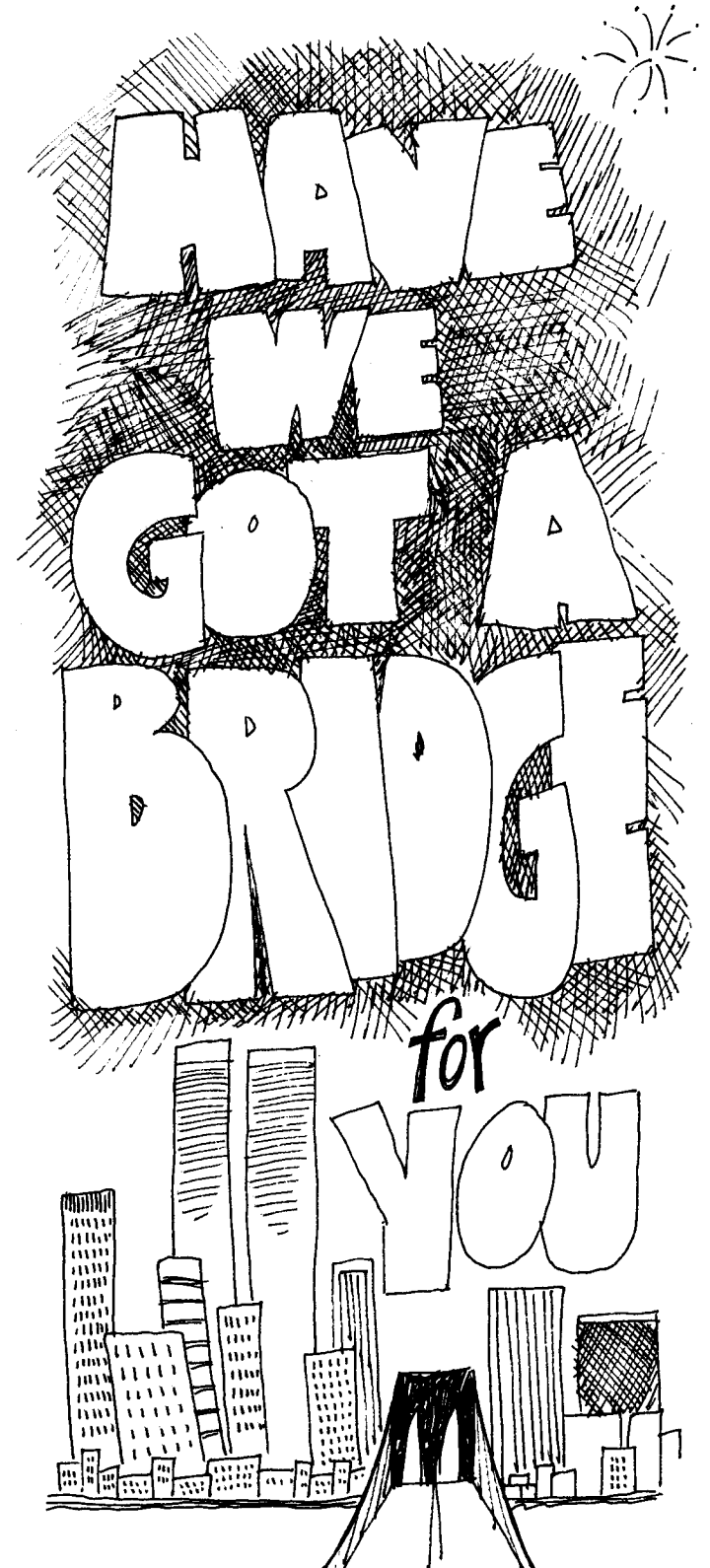

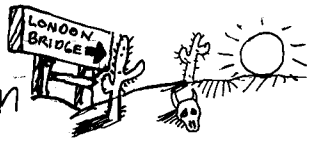

The London Bridge is falling down

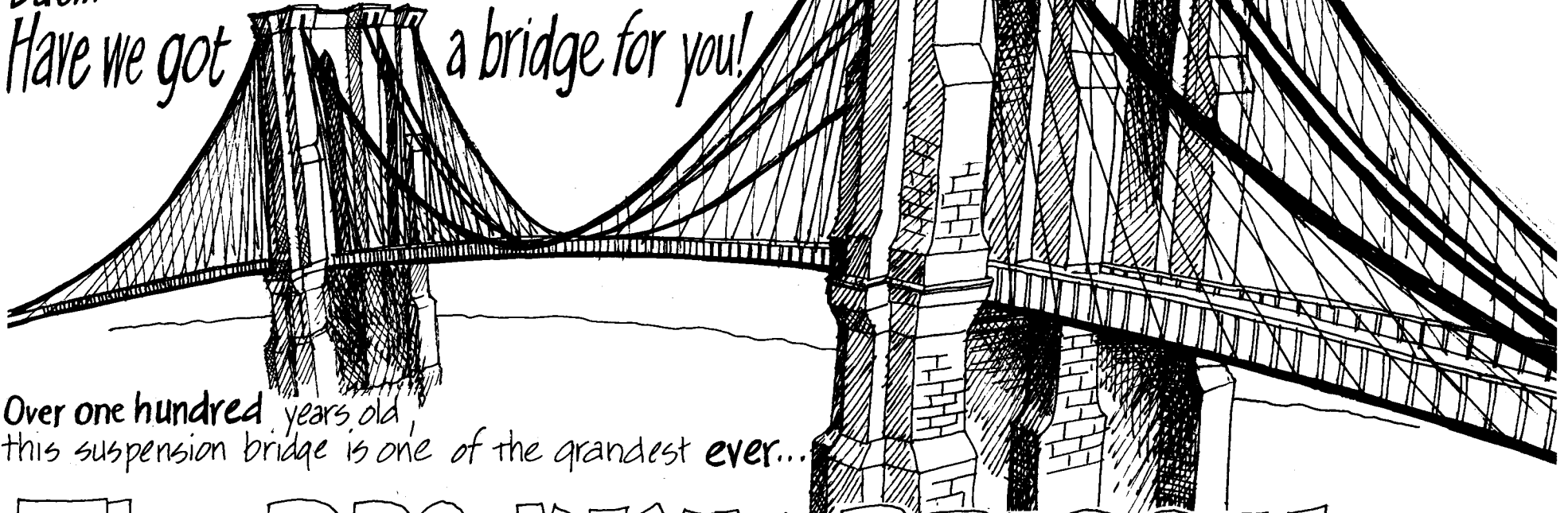


Golden Gate got lost in the fog.

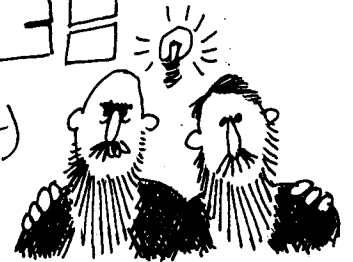


Over one hundred years old, this suspension bridge is one of the grandest ever...
